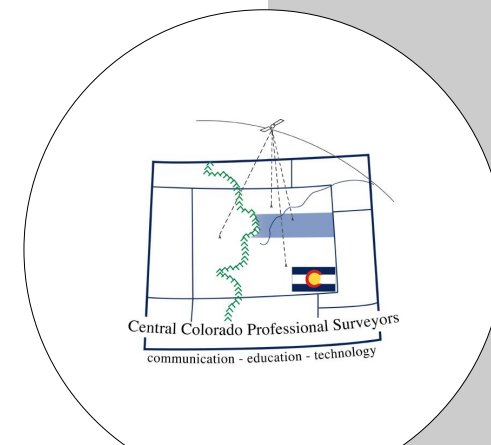
PLSC—Call for Nominations
