

Chapter Summit Questions

1. There are too many Front Range conferences/ workshops that compete with the parent organization, no coordination resulting in duplication of speakers, disruption of finances.

[Should] the Central, Northern and Southern Chapters consolidate their instructional workshops.

The annual Technical Session hosted by PLSC, currently each fall, could be supplemented by an additional session in the spring, to coincide with the CCPS and Board of Directors meetings. This should result in a more comprehensive selection of courses, course offerings at a predictable time every 6 months, and an elimination of duplicate speakers. Revenue sharing by PLSC with these three chapters to compensate for any revenue loss could be part of the agreement. Hosting of a speaker or guest for chapter meetings would not be affected by this consolidation.

The NW1/4, Southwest and Western Chapters are geographically more remote, are not part of the problem, and should continue with their independent workshops as usual.

2. Consolidation of scholarships:

With the Chapters in agreement, the PLSC would like to award scholarships to worthy applicants that are referred by the chapters, with the funds coming from restricted PLSC scholarship accounts. In exchange, the chapters can remit an equal amount to PLSC to support our statewide lobbying efforts, an important function of the PLSC organization that benefits everyone.

3. Communications:

The quarterly journal, *Side Shots*, will continue to be a primary means to disseminate PLSC news and information to all members and chapters. The website will continue to be a source of the same information plus reference material, useful links, membership renewals and any chapter information that is submitted. More urgent communications are best handled by email contact; the PLSC is making progress toward gathering current email information for the entire membership in its revamped database. The PLSC wants members of every chapter to feel connected to the statewide organization, and will do whatever is necessary to make that happen.
